Carol Pinnell-Alison-LSU AgCenter

Mrs. Alison started the report stating that Mark Ricard is no longer with the LSU AgCenter. They are currently in the process of advertising the position, which will close on May 3, 2024. With that, Mrs. Alison announced that she has been filling in since March. She is presently getting names of members that will be attending the 4-H camp this year. The horse show is scheduled for June. We have several participants for that. This year we will be having a horse clinic for those who will take part in the horse show. This will give them a chance to ask questions and be prepared for the show. 4-H University is coming up this summer.

In the Quarterly Report letter, you will see that there were three students from Franklin Parish that took part in that. One of the students won first place and received best in show in his division and one that came in third in her division. Shooting sports was a well-represented group with 37 members participating in that. Franklin Parish had the first place BB Team and one member won 1st place and another that won 2nd place overall in the individual competition.

Quincy has been very busy with Nutrition and Community Health. She has collaborated with Friends of Crowville and they have a school garden at Crowville School. Baskin has come on board with some of her projects and has been given a grant to construct a story walk like the one Crowville had. From an Ag standpoint, we are in the middle of corn planting. Last year we went through a drought with temperatures in excess of 100* and now from January to now we have had lots of rain that has totaled over 20+ inches. Due to low yields and high cost, several farmers have decided to go from corn to soybeans, and possibly a few more cotton acres. With that, Mrs. Alison thanked the board for allowing her to come and update the board

Troy Bell with the Community/Staff Survey results-

Mr. Bell went over the handout of the results that was given to the board members. He started on page two of the handout, which listed the total response. There were 495 responses with 224 from staff survey responses out of 519 employees, which equaled about 43% and 271 from family survey responses, which was an estimate of about 15% of the total families in the parish. Mr. Bell went over the rating scale with five being very satisfied to one being very dissatisfied. He explained the results by each category, which showed most favorable with topics ranging from job satisfaction, employer satisfaction, the four-day week, and the benefits that the four-day week has on students. For the most part employees scored the topics from satisfied to very satisfied. Mr. Bell then discussed the strengths and changes that employees entered as their options.

Mr. Bell continued his report with the Community Survey Results. The questions ranged from overall satisfaction with their child's school, with the district, the four-day week, and a five year overall score. Parents were overall satisfied or very satisfied with Franklin Parish Schools as a whole. Mr. Bell then went over what parents felt were the strengths and what changes needed to be made, to help improve the district.

Mrs. Huff presented Mrs. Tanya Cobb with an award for making the Semi-finals for the State Service Provider of the Year. Mrs. Huff stated that the state of Louisiana started recognizing service providers approximately 2 years ago.

BUSINESS REPORT

Miss Lane gave a copy of the Budget to Actual for the month of March to the school board members. She reported that we are about the same that we have been, we are still slightly less than where we were last year at this time. It is a combination of not receiving all of the indirect cost from ESSERS and the MFP still lower. The total is approximately \$312,000 from last year. Ms. Lane asked if there were any questions. With that, Ms. Lane concluded her report.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Mr. Gullatt opened his report by stating that he has spoken with Danny Walters about any maintenance issues. As of time before the meeting, everything was holding up after the rains we have seen in the past few months. Culverts and gravel were installed at the storage building during Spring Break to help with drainage and to make it easier to enter and exit the building. We should be about ready to begin moving items from the portable building to the new storage building soon.

At this time, schools are gearing up for testing. We need to encourage parents to make sure students are getting plenty of sleep, and making sure, they arrive at school on time. The Legislation is in session at this time. We are watching several bills. Some are controversial to schools. The biggest one concerns school choice. There have been some amendments added to it and taken away. The last was a 10-page amendment added to it. The bill is now headed to the Senate floor and that is when the fun will begin. It seems they are trying to fast track everything to have a Constitutional Convention at the end. At this time, I do not have any updates to give you, but they are asking superintendents to show up when the bill hits the floor. With that, Mr. Gullatt ended his report.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT -

Mr. Bryan opened his report by congratulating, Mrs. Anna Tarver, Gilbert Jr. High School Principal, for making it to the Semi-Finals for State Principal of the Year. We hope to know more about her this summer. One other item I would like to bring up at this time is the importance of community support and options during the board meetings. Here tonight the option of the public mattered. People need to be more involved, because with that the school district will be better off. At this time, Mr. Bryan concluded his report.
