Franklin Parish School Board is Seeking Special Education Advisory Panel Members

In accordance with ACT 274, enacting LA Rev Stat § 17:1944.1, the Franklin Parish School Board is seeking applicants to serve on the Special Education Advisory Panel (SEAP) for Franklin Parish Schools. The purpose of the panel is to provide advice and recommendations regarding special education policies, procedures, and resources. The council shall also engage in outreach activities to the community at large to increase the level of knowledge, support, and collaboration with respect to special education. This is a volunteer position for a three year term period. The panel must include at least eight members, comprise of at least 50% parents or legal guardians of students with an exceptionality, other than gifted and talented, who are enrolled in school under the jurisdiction of Franklin Parish School Board and cannot be an employee*, at least 1 teacher, principal, or paraprofessional who provide services to students with exceptionalities, and at least 10% special stakeholders.

*When there are not at least 50% of parents or legal guardians, one high school student with an exceptionality, other than gifted and talented, and one person who represents an entity that serves students with disabilities or families of students with disabilities and who is not an employee of the school governing authority may be counted to meet the requirement of this.

The application process will be open from May to August of each school year if there are not the appropriate number of members according to the statute. Online applications are available below and should be submitted no later than August 1 of the current year.

This paper application can be completed and submitted to the special education director. All applications will be reviewed and members will be appointed by Mr. John Gullatt, Superintendent of Franklin Parish Schools, by September of the current school year.
